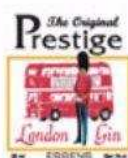


Gins

Of the six essential spirits, Gin is the only one that really has a reputation to live down. Although the English often claim to be the true progenitors of Gin, its origins in fact go back to 16th century Holland.

How to Serve: The old age mixer for Gin is, of course, Schweppes® tonic, the production of which is almost exclusively sustained by gin drinkers. A gin and tonic is usually offered in a long glass with a slice of lemon and plenty of ice, but equal measures are a more sensitive way of treating the gin. Gin rubs along with the old mixer, though: orange juice, bitter lemon, ginger beer and also cola

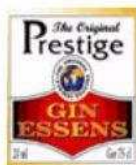
Speciality gins can be served neat. Chill the bottle in the freezer, and serve in measures in small glasses. A taller narrow-sided stemmed glass - rather like a short champagne flute - is traditional in the Netherlands



41036 London Gin - London Gin is a spiced liquor with the pronounced flavour of juniper. Wonderful aromas of juniper right out front and fragrant lavender notes in the back drop. The crisp body shows a complex floral palate with a hint of citrus. Great Martini Gin. Mix with tonic, Schweppes's® Russian, etc., or make a Dry Martini by mixing with Vermouth.



41025 Dutch Genever - Dutch Genever is a gin with flavours of juniper, coriander, angelica and lavender. This Gin is quite different from English Gin, owing to the more pungently flavoured grain mash from which it is made. Dutch Gin (Genever) is often drunk with a beer chaser; the combination is known as a kopstoot ('head butt').



41030 Gin - Gin is a spiced liquor with the distinct flavour of juniper. Reminiscent of spices, minerals, and dried herbs. Medium light body with a delicate, creamy texture, this strong flavoured yet smooth Gin is one of the great classics. Mix with tonic water, grapefruit juice, Schweppes® Russian, etc. or try a Dry Martini by mixing with Vermouth.



41032 Bombay Gin - Bombay Dry Gin is a spiced liquor with the mild, pure flavour of juniper. With flavours reminiscent of citrus and spices with a soft, delicate texture, elegance is the key here. The original Bombay Gin is greatly esteemed and extremely popular. It is a refreshing 86 proof Gin, made from a finely balanced mixture of juniper berries and nine other spices and plant extracts. Mix with Schweppes® Indian Tonic, Schweppes® Grape, Schweppes® Russian, etc., or make a dry martini by mixing with vermouth.



41035 Lemon Gin - Lemon Gin is a mild gin flavoured with lemon. A crisp and balanced juniper flavour with hints of coriander and spices, mixed with fresh lemon and hint of other citrus fruits. Good straight, "on the rocks" or as an ingredient in tall drinks and mixers.



41433 Dry Gin - Established in the 18th century, the Dry Gin is today the world's best selling Gin. The juniper is predominantly in the nose, but well balanced with fresh coriander notes, fresh citrus and spice backdrop on the palate.
